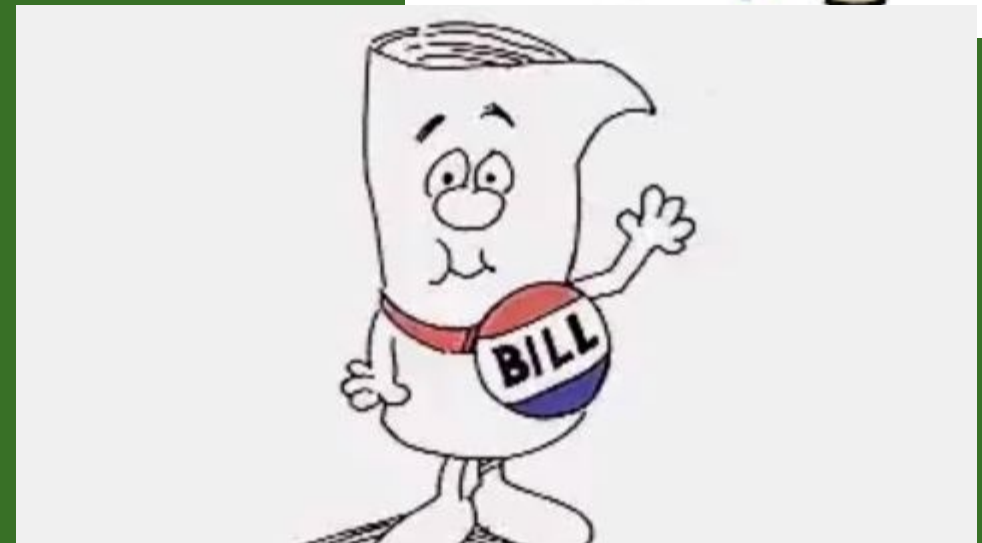

What's up with plastics?



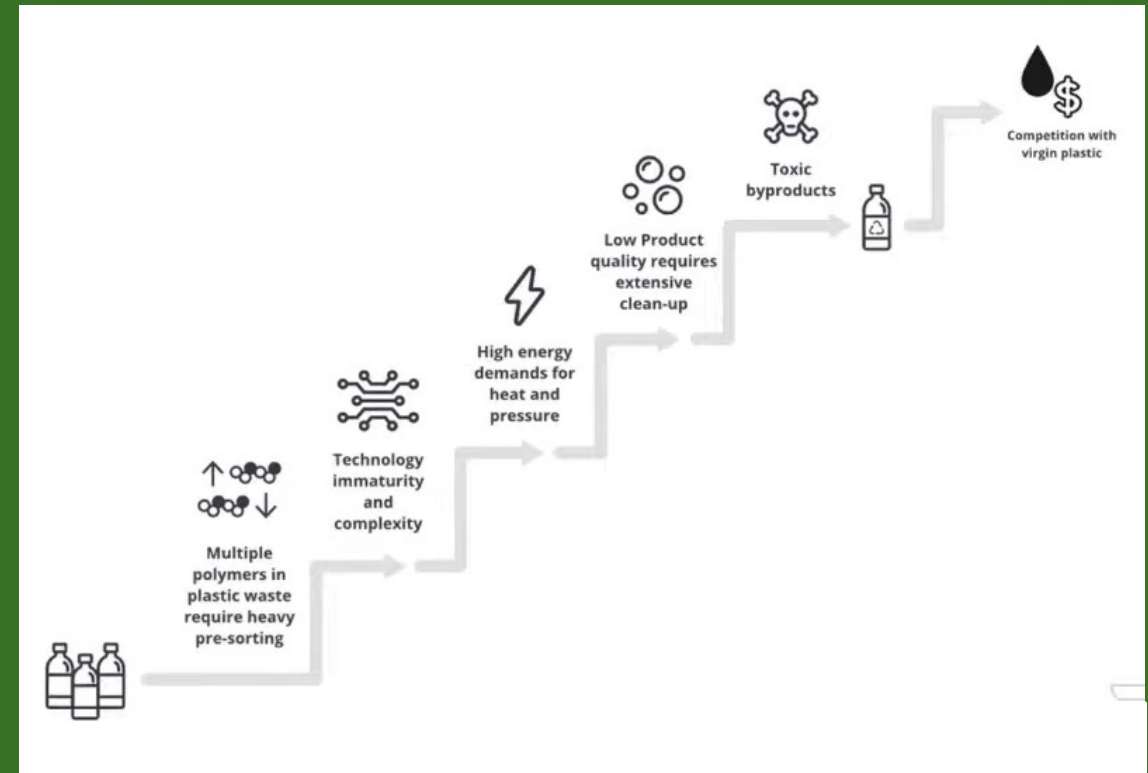
- Recycled Content
 - S2515/A4676
 - Requires certain amt of recycled materials to be used in place of virgin plastic
 - Senate passed, no Asm movement



What's up with plastics?



- Recycling Incineration Bill
 - A5803
 - Assembly Env Committee, no Senate version
 - Exempts incinerators from recycling laws
 - Would increase GHG and expense of recycling
 - Env Justice concerns

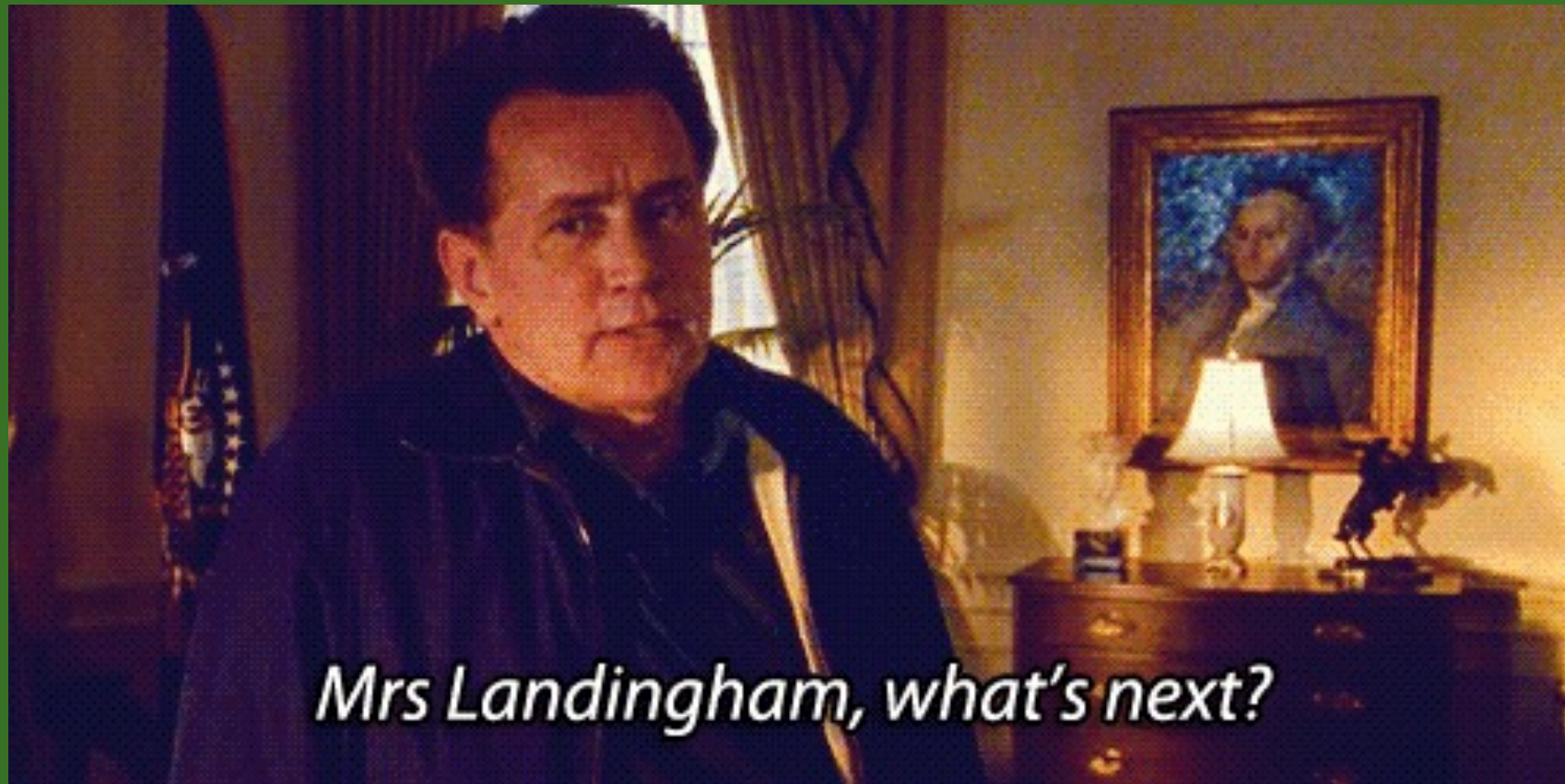

- Two parts:
 - Land use & flooding (Resilient Env and Landscapes)
 - Air quality (Climate Pollutant Reduction)
