Question: Our last ERI is from 2014. I mentioned about updating. Discussion went....we are pretty much built out & not much has changed. Does a ERI have to be updated. State Regulation wise? How often? Our Planning Bd is in the middle of updating Master Plan.

Answer: It's a good idea to time the ERI update with the Master Plan Update. Recommended maximum of ten years between updates.

Question: What is the rough budget that needs to be available to do an ERI?

Answer: Typical ERI costs between \$15-\$20K

Question: Should the EC write up the specs for an RFP?. Aside from showing an ERI prototype should each community focus on specific issues that affect them?

Answer: Yes the EC should be managing the whole project including the RFP. Yes, any specific/ unique features of your community should be inventoried.

Question: Can two communities sharing a 7 Mile Island conduct one ERI and cost share?

Answer: It's not the usual way but, why not think about it, particularly in this case it may work well for all concerned.

Question: You say "up to date", what is considered up to date?

Answer: We recommend maximum of ten years between reviews/updates.

Question: What do you mean by "category 1" streams, how many categories are there and what do the numbers indicate?

Answer: Category One (C1) Waters: Are protected from any measurable change in water quality because of their exceptional ecological significance, exceptional recreational significance, exceptional water supply significance, or exceptional fisheries resources.
