Protecting and Preserving High Quality Open Spaces

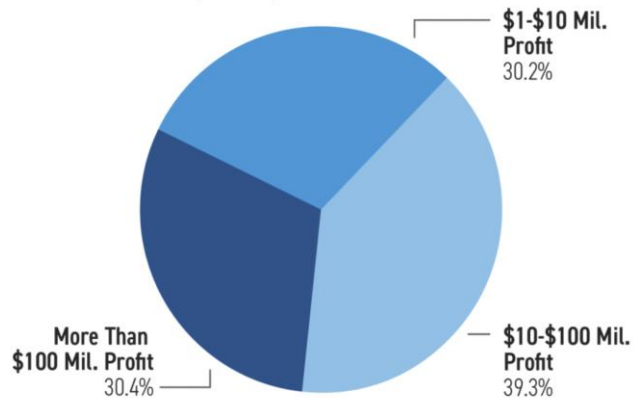
- Advocates for the preservation and stewardship of New Jersey's parks, farmland, historic sites and natural areas

- Keep It Green helped to secure a permanent funding source for open spaces
- Since 2018, a 2.5% CBT surtax on corporate profits over \$1 million
 - Set to expire at the end of this year
 - We stand to lose over **\$40 million** in land preservation funding a year
