
Behavioral Program

Program Offerings

- Customers receive direct mailed and/or electronic Home Energy Reports ("HERs" and "eHERs," collectively "HERs")
 - Reports provide participants with customized, easy to implement action steps and recommendations to reduce energy consumption and support behavior modification for improved energy efficiency
 - A view of the customers' historical energy consumption compared to peer group customers





ATLANTIC CITY ELECTRIC RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS

Appliance Recycling

Eligible Participants:

- Receive \$100 for working refrigerator or freezer;
 \$35 for working room air conditioner or dehumidifier
- Open to residential Atlantic City Electric customers with a valid account number

Program Offerings

- Appliance(s) is picked up at no charge from the address listed on the billing account
- Appliance(s) must be in working condition to receive the incentive. Unable to accept any units with mold or mildew damage.
- After the appliance pickup and confirmation that the appliance is in working condition, a check will be mailed to the address on file within four to six weeks.

HVAC Efficiency

Energy Wise Rewards

Eligible Participants:

How does it work

- Atlantic City Electric will initiate conservation periods for participating central air conditioners or heat pumps on Peak Savings Days, the select summer days when energy demand is highest
- May be eligible to receive a no-cost smart thermostat through Atlantic City Electric's Whole Home Energy Assessment program






