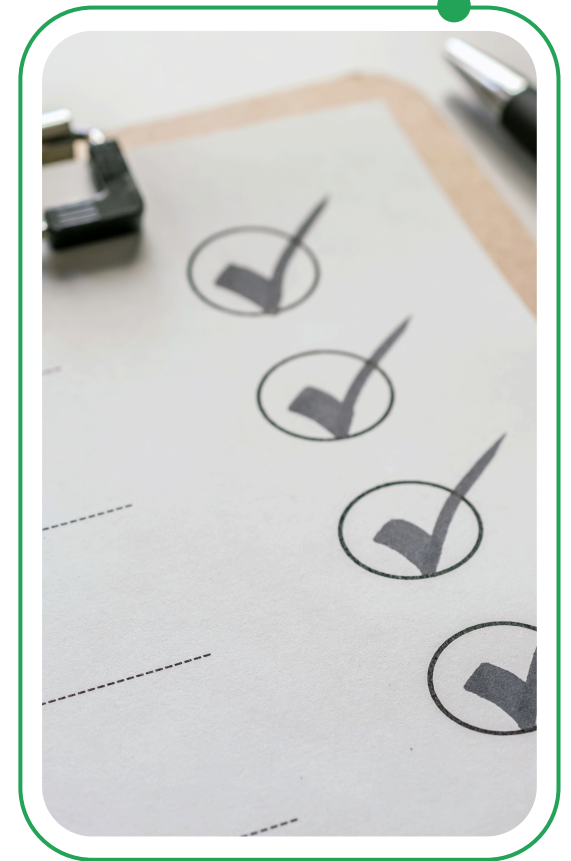

Points System for Public Education and Outreach Activities

Municipalities are required to run a Public Education and Outreach Program that focuses on educational and pollution prevention activities about the impacts of stormwater discharges on surface water and groundwater and to involve the public in reducing pollutants in stormwater runoff and mitigating flow. Permittees must earn at least 12 points in at least three of the five categories.

Category 1 -

General Public Outreach

- Social Media - 3 points
- Newspaper Ad - 1 point
- Radio/TV - 2 points
- Green Infrastructure Signage - 5 points
- Billboard/sign - 2 points
- Mural - 2 points
- Stormwater Facility Signage - 5 points



Category 2 - Targeted Audiences Outreach

- Stormwater Display - 1 point
- Promotional Item - 2 points
- Private Stormwater Facilities Education - 3 points
- Mailing/Emailing Campaign - 2 points
- Ordinance Education - 3 points

Category 3 - School/Youth Education and Activities

- School Presentations - 5 points
- Water Education Workshop-2 pts
- Storm Drain Labeling - 3 points
- Educational Contest for Schools - 3 points
- AmeriCorps Event - 4 points
- Cleanup - 3 points

Category 4 - Watershed/Regional Collaboration

- Regional Stormwater Collaboration - 3 points
- Green Infrastructure Workshop - 3 points
- Community Activity - 3 points

Category 5 - Community Involvement Activities

- Volunteer Stormwater Assessment or Stream Monitoring - 3 points
- Rain Barrel Workshop - 3 points
- Rain Garden Workshop - 3 points
- Community Event - 3 points
- Community Involvement - 5 points
